

Scheduling your FAA Knowledge Exam

Before scheduling your FAA Knowledge Exam, you must first register an account.

To do this, please refer to the directions below:

1- Go to the PSI True Talent Portal

- a. <https://faa.psiexams.com/faa/login>

2- To begin your registration, click on “Create an Account”.

- a. For this section, you will need your FTN number which is linked to your IACRA account.
- b. When you and your instructor applied for your student pilot certificate, you would have received your FTN number then... if you have not done the student pilot certificate application through IACRA, then complete this application with an instructor first then continue with the following instructions.
- c. To reference your FTN number, login to your IACRA account and look for the number next to “FTN” in the “User Information” box in the upper left corner of your screen.
 - i. IACRA is the only location to create and reference your FTN number.

3- After creating your account, select “Sign In” on the PSI True Talent Portal Home Page.

- a. Choose the “Select” tab on the home page of your account and select the FAA Knowledge Exam you plan on taking.
- b. The following have been provided as a reference of exams that are commonly taken at GBA:
 - i. PAR = Private Pilot Airplane
 - ii. IRA = Instrument Rating Airplane
 - iii. CAX = Commercial Pilot Airplane
 - iv. FOI = Fundamental of Instruction
 - v. FIA = Flight Instructor Airplane

4- Make sure you selected the correct exam, then fill out the Pre-Exam Data Collection section.

5- Select a date for your exam and select a facility to take your exam.

- a. We recommend the testing center named “Brainseed Testing Services – Reno” located at 5250 Neil Rd, Reno, NV, 89502
- b. A map of this location is provided on the backside of this sheet

6- To complete your exam registration, you will have to pay a required fee.
