

# **REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT PILOTS TO SOLO AT GREAT BASIN AVIATION**

- Be in possession of a valid FAA Medical (at least Third Class)
- Be in possession of a valid Student Pilot Certificate
- Complete appropriate flight training requirements as outlined in FAR 61.87 (including pre-solo written exam; not the same as the PPL Knowledge Test)
- Complete and log flight training in the Cessna/King syllabus adopted by GBA through all of Stage 1, Phases 1-5, all Scenarios (except Phase 5, Scenario 3 that happens after solo)
- Complete the Pre-Solo Phase Check by a GBA Check Pilot to the standards outlined in Cessna/King Syllabus Stage 1, Phase 5, Scenario 1 Progress Check (all items within tolerances outlined)
- Have appropriate non-owned aircraft insurance
- Primary Instructor sign-off and appropriate endorsements (typically happens shortly after all other items are complete)
