Our certified mechanics meticulously maintain each plane, ensuring peak performance and airworthiness for every flight. Featuring modern avionics and renowned models like the C172S, our fleet blends advanced technology with proven designs to enhance safety and learning. While the average privately owned aircraft flies just 100–150 hours a year, our planes routinely fly over 100 hours a month—a testament to their reliability and rigorous maintenance. Things may wear or break over time, but airworthiness is never compromised.

We know that pilots often get a favorite plane. That's a normal thing; we all have our favorites too. We'll do our best to ensure the plane you book is the one you fly, but sometimes that isn't possible. All of the aircraft are the same under the hood and are almost identical on the panel (G1000 excepted, of course). Any squawks that crop up get dealt with during frequent maintenance. Because of this, we encourage you to fly all of the planes! It's good experience plus allows for much greater flexibility with your bookings.

Embrace the opportunity get familiar with the entire fleet—each plane has its character, but all are maintained to the highest standards to ensure your safety and success as a pilot.

### REMINDERS FOR THE UPCOMING WEEK

- Watch for wing covers and frost. DO NOT put the flaps down with the wing covers on.
- In the event of frost formation on your aircraft, you and your CFI will be put to work in helping remove it. Please make sure you have a line technician or a CFI helping you with frost removal. Teamwork is crucial here!
- Top of The Hour Reservations All GBA flights are scheduled on the hour, not the half-hour, to keep operations efficient.
- Please report any anomalies before flying and any issues or damage immediately after the flight to ensure safety and airworthiness.


