TAKE CARE OF YOUR AIRCRAFT – LEAVE IT BETTER THAN YOU FOUND IT

When you rent an aircraft, you're responsible for keeping it clean, intact, and ready for the next pilot. Just like in the wilderness, leave no trace.

Handle With Care

- Use proper hand grips—DO NOT SLAM DOORS.
- Be gentle with switches, controls, and seat adjustments. If it doesn't move easily, don't force it.

Keep It Clean

- Wipe off suction cup marks from the windscreen.
- Take out your trash—no used checklists, wrappers, or water bottles.
- If you scuff it, clean it—a quick wipe-down keeps it professional.

Respect the Equipment

- Don't let the yoke or pedals snap back—they're connected to flight control cables.
- Double-check everything is secure—control locks, chocks, windows, doors, and fuel caps.

A little extra care means fewer maintenance issues, fewer delays, and a better experience for all. Treat every aircraft like it's your own, and leave it better than you found it! Thank you for your help with keeping the fleet maintained.

REMINDERS FOR THE UPCOMING WEEK

- Watch for wing covers and frost. DO NOT put the flaps down with the wing covers on.
- In the event of frost formation on your aircraft, you and your CFI will be put to work in helping remove it.
 Please make sure you have a line technician or a CFI helping you with frost removal. Teamwork is crucial here!
- Please pay attention to your parking at the end of the day. A parking map will be posted on top of the locker. If you have questions interpreting the map, please let me know and I'll answer your questions.
- Please report any anomalies before flying and any issues or damage immediately after the flight to ensure safety and airworthiness.
