#### **RUNWAY 17R-35L CONSTRUCTION NOTIFICATION**

As you may know, over the next several months, Runway 17R-35L (west parallel runway) will be closed for construction, set to begin August 12, 2024. This will include the closure of associated taxiways throughout the course of construction.

#### Key takeaways:

- Runway 17R-35L will close on August 12, 2024, at 0600 hrs (PDT) and will not reopen until the project is completed.
- Project completion date is scheduled for November 20, 2024, at 1159 hrs (midnight) and the runway re-opened on November 21, 2024.
- Intermittent closures may occur through January 15, 2025.
- Pilots must stay current on all NOTAMS.



#### REMINDERS FOR THE UPCOMING WEEK

- Be smart about the smoke! It is not just visibility, but remember, you are sucking it in while you are up there flying. Don't forget the human factor side of flying in smokey conditions.
- If you are rated for the aircraft you are flying, a friendly reminder that you do need a renter's policy. We will not be dispatching unless it is on file. This includes safety pilots.
